RESOLUTION 2022-17

A RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE FISCAL YEAR 2021-22 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Town is required to reflect changes to the budget by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the Firehall Fund (2384) has exceeded budgeted appropriations and the Town would like to increase the expenditure budget of the Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Electric Fund (5710) has exceeded budgeted appropriations and the Town would like to increase the expenditure budget of the Fund; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-6-4031, MCA, the Town Council of Philipsburg desires to amend its final budget for fiscal year 2021-22 to reflect the increased amounts expended in that fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED By the Town Council of Philipsburg:

That the fiscal year 2021-22 Firehall Fund expenditure budget account line be amended to reflect an increase of \$5,064.82 for a total expenditure of \$43,374.82.

That the fiscal year 2021-22 Electric Fund expenditure budget account line be amended to reflect an increase of \$7,295.90 for a total expenditure of \$60,289.90.
