

TOWN OF PHILIPSBURG RESOLUTION 2021-10  
A RESOLUTION CANCELLING THE NOVEMBER 2, 2021 GENERAL ELECTION OF CERTAIN  
MUNICIPAL OFFICERS

**WHEREAS**, HB 447 passed by the 2017 Legislature authorizes a municipality to cancel a general election for the election of a municipal officer by resolution after notification by the election administrator if the number of candidates filing for election is equal or less than the number of positions to be filled; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 3, 2021, the Town of Philipsburg received notice by the Granite County Election Administrator that the elected municipal officer positions of mayor and four positions of town councilperson are eligible for cancellation; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 13-1-403, as amended by HB 83 (Chapter 242, Laws 2017), provides that a declaration of intent to be a write-in candidate must be filed with the election administrator by 5 p.m. on the 65<sup>th</sup> day before the date of the election, or August 30, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, as of October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the municipal officer positions of mayor and each position of town councilperson remain eligible for cancellation:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Town of Philipsburg cancels the November 2, 2021 general election for the municipal officer positions of mayor and each position of town councilperson that was to come up for a vote,
2. The following persons are hereby elected to the following municipal officer positions by acclamation:
  1. Daniel Reddish, Mayor, for a full four year term,
  2. DuWayne Ulrich, Councilperson, for a full four year term,
  3. Carl Sundstrom, Councilperson, for the remaining two years of the term for that seat,
  4. John Laigaie, Councilperson, for a full four year term,
  5. Jason White, Councilperson, for the remaining two years of the term for that seat,
