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RESOLUTION 2021-17

A GRANITE COUNTY RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN UPDATED AND AMENDED GRANITE COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN DATED NOVEMBER 2021

WHEREAS, all residents and property within Granite County are at risk from a wide range of hazards such as, but not limited to, avalanche, communicable disease, communications failure, dam failure, drought, earthquake, extended cold, flooding, hazardous materials release, landslide, severe thunderstorms, terrorism, tornadoes, transportation accidents, utility failure, volcanic ash, water supply/watershed contamination, wildfire, wind and winter storms; and,

WHEREAS, Granite County, pursuant to Section 322, Mitigation Planning of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, enacted by Section 104 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (P.L. 106-390) and the Interim Final Rule published in the Federal Register on February 26, 2002 at 44 CFR Part 201, is required to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to receive future federal disaster mitigation funds; and,

WHEREAS, Granite County adopted a Hazard Mitigation Plan by Resolution in 2006 and 2013, but an updated and amended Hazard Mitigation Plan will more effectively guide Granite County in making decisions for pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation projects; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Granite County, Montana, hereby adopts Granite County's Hazard Mitigation Plan dated November 2021 which supersedes and amends all previously plans.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this current Resolution may be amended from time to time, and is effective immediately.
