RESOLUTION 2022-04

A RESOLUTION TO REVISE THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Town is required to reflect changes to the budget by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Insurance Fund (2190) has exceeded budgeted appropriations and the Town would like to increase the expenditure budget of the Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Library Fund (2220) has exceeded budgeted appropriations and the Town would like to increase the expenditure budget of the Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the Electric Fund (5710) has exceeded budgeted appropriations and the Town would like to increase the expenditure budget of the Fund; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to §7-6-4031, MCA, the Town Council of Philipsburg desires to amend its final budget for fiscal year 2020-21 to reflect the increased amounts expended in that fiscal year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED By the Town Council of Philipsburg:

That the fiscal year 2020-21 Comprehensive Insurance Fund expenditure budget account line be amended to reflect an increase of \$749.50 for a total expenditure of \$30,162.50.

That the fiscal year 2020-21 Library Fund expenditure budget account line be amended to reflect an increase of \$12.58 for a total expenditure of \$12.58.

That the fiscal year 2020-21 Electric Fund expenditure budget account line be amended to reflect an increase of \$16,794.09 for a total expenditure of \$57,629.09.
