Authorize Submission of CDBG Application for Fred Burr Transmission

Line Replacement Drinking Water Project

Whereas, the Town of Philipsburg is applying to the Montana Department of Commerce for financial assistance from the Community Development Block Grant Program to replace all or some portion of the Fred Burr Drinking water supply transmission line:

Whereas, the Town of Philipsburg has legal jurisdiction and authority to construct, finance, operate, and maintain the Transmission line; That the Town of Philipsburg agrees to comply with all applicable parts of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, which have not been cited herein, as well as with other applicable federal laws and regulations, and all state laws and regulations and the requirements described in the CDBG Community and Public Facilities Application Guidelines and those that are described in the CDBG Grant.

That the Town of Philipsburg commits to provide the amount of matching funds as proposed in the CDBG Public and Community Facilities application; and
