RESOLUTION 2021-12

A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING ARPA LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUNDS TO THE WATER FUND

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) via the State of Montana legislature determined a distribution of funds to cities, towns, counties, and consolidated city-county governments,

WHEREAS, the Town of Philipsburg ("Town") was allocated \$236,479.62 as Local Fiscal Recovery Funds and the Town has received the first half of these in the total of \$118,239.81,

WHEREAS, these funds must be used for water, sewer, and broadband projects for the Town,

WHEREAS, the Town recently completed the replacement of a section of the Fred Burr Main Transmission Line at a total estimated cost of \$235,254.89,

WHEREAS, the Town paid for this project using monies from the Water Fund,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The Town will transfer \$118,239.81 from the ARPA Fund to the Water Fund to pay for a portion of the Fred Burr Water Transmission Main project.


